RESOLUTION NO. 6-31-2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING EXCLUSION OF THE PUBLIC FROM A MEETING BETWEEN THE TOWNSHIP COMMITTEE, THE TOWNSHIP CLERK, AND THE TOWNSHIP SOLICITOR CONCERNING CONTRACT NEGOTIATIONS IN WHICH THE PUBLIC BODY IS OR MAY BECOME A PARTY AND AUTHORIZING DISCLOSURE OF MINUTES OF SAID MEETING AS PROVIDED HEREIN

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 10:4-12, Open Public Meetings Act, permits the exclusion of the public from the meeting of a public body where the subject matter of that meeting involves personnel matters;

WHEREAS, the Township Committee of the Township of Greenwich desires to meet with the Township Clerk and the Township Solicitor, concerning contract negotiations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Township Committee of the Township of Greenwich that:

1. The public shall be excluded from a meeting of the Township Committee of the Township of Greenwich on Thursday, June 2, 2016, at 1000 Ye Greate Street, Greenwich, New Jersey.
2. The general nature of the subject matters of the closed meeting shall pertain to contract negotiations.

3. Disclosure of the minutes of the closed meeting authorized above between the Township Committee, the Township Clerk and the Township Solicitor shall be made following a final decision and determination of said matter which is estimated to be 30 days.
4. The Clerk at the present public meeting shall read the title of said Resolution aloud so that members of the public in attendance can understand as precisely as possible the nature of the matter that will privately be discussed.
5. This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
6. The Clerk on the next business day following this meeting shall furnish a copy of the Resolution to any member of the public who requests one at the fees allowed by N.J.S.A. 47:1A-1, et seq..

On motion of Mayor Reinhart, seconded by Deputy Mayor Orr to approve and adopt the foregoing resolution, unanimously carried.
