

**TOWNSHIP OF GREENWICH  
MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING  
JULY 5, 2016  
7:30 P.M.**

Mayor Reinhart called the meeting to order stating, “Adequate notice of this meeting was provided in compliance with the Open Public Meeting Act by notifying the South Jersey Times on June 18, 2016”.

Those present were Mayor Reinhart, Deputy Mayor Orr and Committeeman Werley. Also present were: Kim Fleetwood, Treasurer; John Carr, Township Solicitor; and Lisa Garrison Township Clerk.

Flag Salute – Mayor Reinhart

Payment of Bills – After review and discussion of the bill list, on motion of Committeeman Werley, seconded by Deputy Mayor Orr to approve the bills for payment in the amount of \$75,578.43, unanimously carried.

Mayor Reinhart called for approval of the minutes of June 14, 2016. On motion of Mayor Reinhart, seconded by Deputy Mayor Orr to approve said minutes, unanimously carried.

Unfinished Business:

Fuel Spill Cleanup – Mayor Reinhart indicated he had received an email from the engineer to schedule a meeting this week to review the limits of the digging, testing, shoring, means, methods and status of drawings. Mayor Reinhart is inviting the Committee to attend.

The proposed area was reviewed. Mayor Reinhart indicated he will forward the email to the rest of the Committee. Laury Heating indicated new air conditioners are needed and will cost \$6,000.00. Additional quotes will be received. Mayor Reinhart contacted the project manager advising the cost was unacceptable. Ms. Garrison indicated she will reach out to the Treasury Department in regards to the funds for the project and advise Mr. Carr who will reach out to the State.

Quotes – Removal of File Cabinets - Mayor Reinhart indicated two (2) quotes were received in the amount of \$1,100 by Jake Davis of Bridgeton and \$350 by DeSoto Movers of Vineland. Mayor Reinhart will reach out to DeSoto Movers.

RFQ – mowing - Responses were requested by July 5, 2016. No responses were received. In the meantime and due to the emergent nature, Mr. Latourette will do the emergency work.

RFQ – snow removal – Responses are due in August.

Sale of Excess Property - Ms. Mazza is reviewing. The Committee will list for the next meeting. Mr. Carr indicated a resolution will be presented for the next meeting and if the Committee chooses to act on said resolution the sale will be held after the meeting. Mr. Carr will place in the newspaper and website.

Demolition Church – Sheppards Mill- Tony Riviera, CCIA, believes he will be able to find the funds for the tipping fees as it is a church. The deed must be found.

New Business: None

Solicitor Report:

Mr. Carr indicated one (1) response had been received for the maintenance of the Township website. He recommended a trial period of two (2) months. Ms. Hansen will be ceasing the maintenance of the website as of August 31, 2016. He issued concerns regarding a Committee member maintaining the website. Committeeman Werley indicated there will be expense for the website. An invitation will be issued for the one applicant to attend the next meeting.

Committee Comments:

Committeeman Werley indicated the Dike Committee meeting will be held tomorrow. Mayor Reinhart indicated he is unable to report on the fire calls for the month as the Fire Company has not yet met. Committeeman Werley indicated there is a gutter that needs to be repaired. Mayor Reinhart requested change of meeting date for October. The Committee will review at the next meeting. Mayor Reinhart publicly thanked Ms. Hanson for all of the time, sweat and energy placed in the website. He reminded the public the senior center is open and active.

Public Comment – On motion of Deputy Mayor Orr, seconded by Mayor Reinhart to open the public comment, unanimously carried. Mr. Carluzzo requested fans for the next meeting if there is no air conditioning. Mayor Reinhart indicated if the issue is not handled before the next meeting the location will be changed to the Fire House. Paul Marish questioned about the doors for the fire house. Mayor Reinhart indicated an answer must be given by the Fire Department as it has already been approved by the Committee. On motion of Deputy Mayor Orr, seconded by Mayor Reinhart to close the public comment, unanimously carried.

Adjournment – On motion of Deputy Mayor Orr, seconded by Mayor Reinhart to adjourn, unanimously carried.
