

**TOWNSHIP OF GREENWICH
PLANNING/ZONING BOARD
REGULAR MEETING
AUGUST 3, 2015**

The regular meeting was called to order by Chairman Rork.

Old Business - Mayor Reinhart thanked Mr. Lamanteer for acting on the properties mentioned at the Township Committee meeting. Mr. Lamanteer indicated he sent letters out via registered mail and is waiting on responses. Mr. Lamanteer utilized all three ordinances. Ms. Watson indicated the lot on the side of Friends Meeting had previously been cut by Mr. Latourette but now it has grown up worse than before.

New Business - Mr. Henry, Ms. Watson and Mr. Ivanick met with individuals from State of New Jersey Sustainable Jersey to start the resiliency process. One of several steps are completed projects will be identified for flood protection and how to bring the township back after suffering from a storm. Maintaining township operations and surviving a storm, not in the strict sense of flood protection. Mr. Ivanick indicated Continuity of Operations was discussed. DEP indicated all the assets can be named but not all of them can be protected. A tough decision will have to be made in the future. Mr. Henry indicated Jim Carluzzo was also present at the meeting.
