

**GREENWICH TOWNSHIP  
MINUTES OF WORKSHOP MEETING  
JANUARY 15, 2019  
7:00 p.m.**

Mayor Reinhart called the meeting to order stating, “Adequate notice of this meeting was provided in compliance with the Open Public Meeting Act by notifying the News of South Jersey on January 8, 2019.

Mayor Reinhart led the Flag Salute which was followed by Roll Call. Those present were: Mayor Reinhart, Deputy Mayor Orr and Committeeman Werley. Also present were: Kim Fleetwood, Treasurer; and Lisa Garrison, Township Clerk.

Township Committee reviewed the Capital Improvement budget along with contractual increases, planning/zoning office 2019 needs and grant cash match needs. The Committee indicated they wanted no increase in the local purpose tax. Ms. Fleetwood will work the budget preparation based on the comments forthcoming from the Township Committee. Another budget meeting will be scheduled on a date yet to be determined.

Public Comment – On motion of Deputy Mayor Orr, seconded by Mayor Reinhart to open the public comment, unanimously carried. Mr. Glaspey indicated the State Bond issue was passed at the last election and questioned when the Township Committee would be notified of the amount to be received for school security. He was advised to contact the local school board as they would be notified not the Township Committee. Mr. Carluzzo questioned why no agenda had been posted to the website. Ms. Garrison indicated she in error had not sent it but the notice for the workshop meeting had been published in the newspaper. On motion of Mayor Reinhart, seconded by Committeeman Werley to close the public comment.

There being no further business to come before the Township Committee on motion of Deputy Mayor Orr and seconded by Mayor Reinhart to adjourn, unanimously carried.
