

**TOWNSHIP OF GREENWICH**  
**MINUTES OF REGULAR MEETING**  
**JULY 11, 2017**  
**7:30 P.M.**

Mayor Reinhart called the meeting to order stating, "Adequate notice of this meeting was provided in compliance with the Open Public Meeting Act by notifying the South Jersey Times."

Those present were Mayor Reinhart, Deputy Mayor Orr and Mark Werley. Also present were Mary Lake, CFO; Kim Fleetwood, Treasurer; John Carr, Township Solicitor; and Lisa Garrison Township Clerk.

Flag Salute – Mayor Reinhart

Treasurer's Report/Bill List - The OEM has the opportunity to purchase a 2005 Dodge Durango for \$150.00 from the County OEM to be used by the OEM Coordinator for emergencies within the Township and for meetings. After review and discussion the Committee concurred to purchase the 2005 Dodge Durango for \$150.00 , on motion of Deputy Mayor Orr, seconded by Committeeman Werley to approve the Treasurer's report and Bill List in the amount of \$170,256.59 which includes the \$150.00 purchase, unanimously carried.

Minutes – tabled.

Unfinished Business:

Fire Truck Tender –Deputy Mayor Orr issued concerns regarding the expense for a community the size of Greenwich. Committeeman Werley indicated the current tender is not safe. Mayor Reinhart indicated he is looking toward next year. Options were reviewed and will be considered when revaluation is nailed down.

Revaluation: Mr. Carr indicated a proposal was received from Professional Property Appraisers in the amount of \$56, 295. Ms. Lake indicated an ordinance and resolution will be needed to set in place the funding.

Mowing Quotes - On motion of Mayor Reinhart, seconded by Deputy Mayor Orr to approve the quote from David L Construction, unanimously carried.

OEM Building - Mr. Carr indicated he will send additional correspondence.

New Business –

October meeting – The meeting will be changed to October 17, 2017.

Tax Bills - may be late due to State school funding formula.

Solicitor Report: Mr. Carr reviewed his report with the Committee.

Committee Comments: Committeeman Werley indicated a Dike Committee meeting had been held but there was nothing to report. Deputy Mayor Orr questioned the ratio calculation which requires the revaluation. Mayor Reinhart reported on the calls for the month of May as follows: Fire Calls – 4 EMS Calls-3 , YTD Calls – 54. Mayor Reinhart reported the tower should be completed by the end of October.

Public Comment – On motion of Mayor Reinhart, seconded by Deputy Mayor Orr to open the public comment, unanimously carried. Mr. Carluzzo questioned if grants were being pursued for the purchase of the tender. He indicated he had contacted Congressman LoBiondo’s office and was advised the application time has passed and was missed. There being no comment forthcoming from the public on motion of Deputy Mayor Orr, seconded by Mayor Reinhart to close the public comment, unanimously carried.

Adjournment – On motion of Deputy Mayor Orr, seconded by Mayor Reinhart to adjourn, unanimously carried.
