PROPOSED ORDINANCE NO. 94-2026**

ORDINANCE VACATING CURRENT CANNABIS ORDINANCES 92-2025 AND 91-2025

WHEREAS, public concern has been raised concerning notice and opportunity of the public to be heard on the issue of adopting ordinances concerning cannabis operations in Greenwich Township; and

WHEREAS, there has been litigation which resulted in the current ordinance being set aside. The committee in exercise of its discretion has agreed to vacate previous approvals in favor of allowing robust public input on the issue.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Committee of the Township of Greenwich that the previously introduced and adopted the following ordinances:

- a. Ordinance # 92-2025: An Ordinance Providing for the Setting of Municipal Standards and Qualifications, Applications and Fees and Administration for the Licensing of Medical and Personal Use of Cannabis Establishments in the Township of Greenwich Pursuant to the New Jersey Cannabis Regulatory, Enforcement Assistance, and Marketplace Modernization Act
- b. Ordinance #91-2025: An Ordinance of the Township of Greenwich, Cumberland County, Permitting the Operation of Certain Classes of Cannabis Business Within Its Geographical Boundaries and Amending the Code of the Township of Greenwich

By this ordinance, both ordinances are hereby vacated and rendered moot.

BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED that the Township of Greenwich Committee intends to reintroduce replacement ordinances and republish and issue new notices as may afford the public ample notice and comply with the statutes for consideration on such reintroduction.
